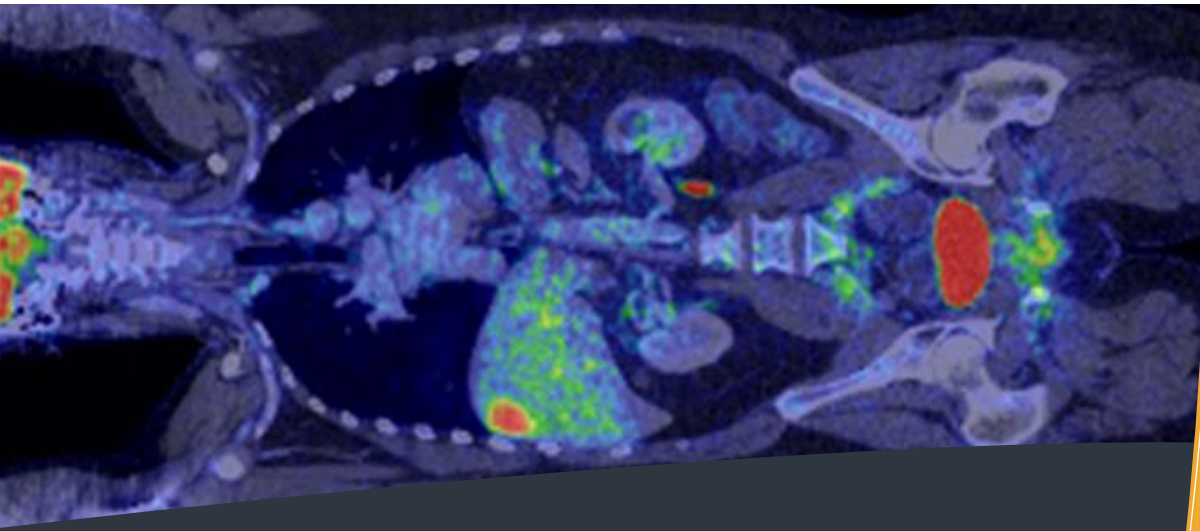

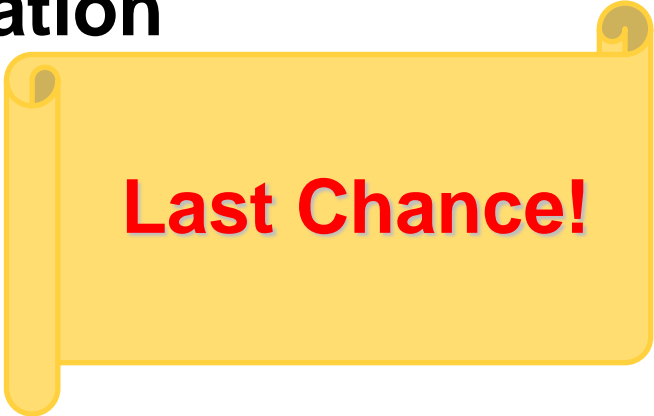
RAINS AWARD
